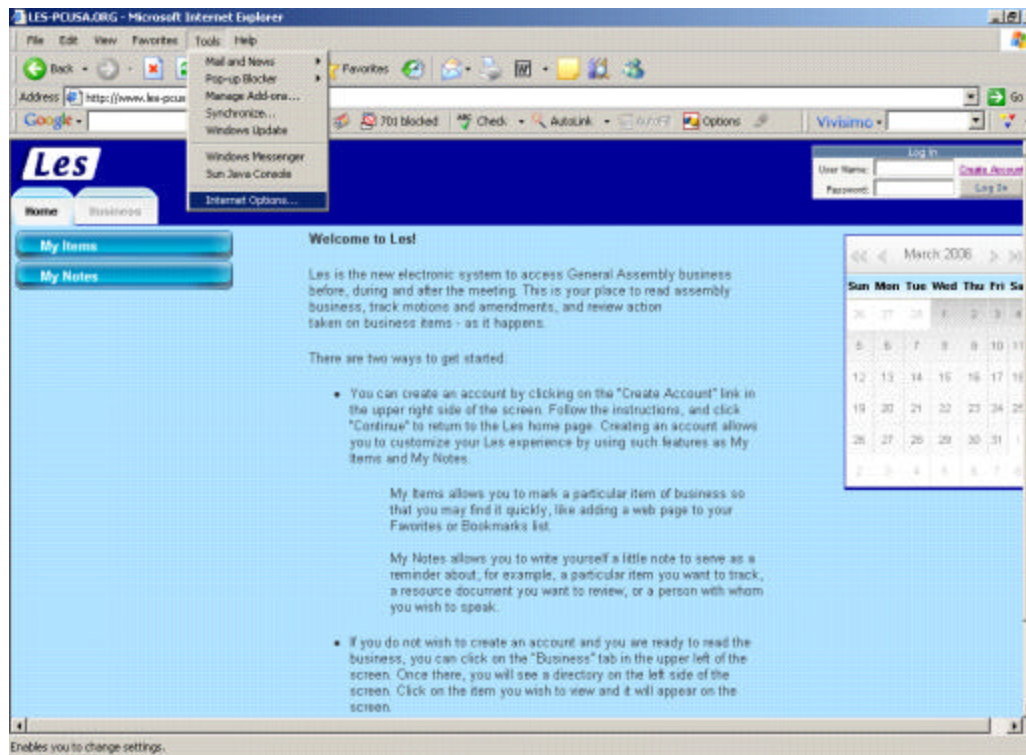


This document is a step-by-step guide to setting your Internet Explorer browser to work with Les, the electronic system to display General Assembly business.

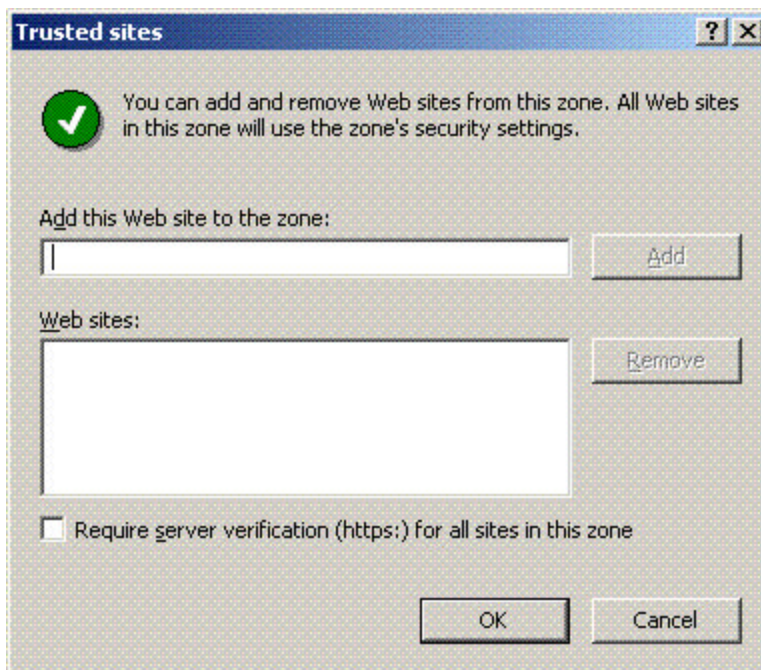
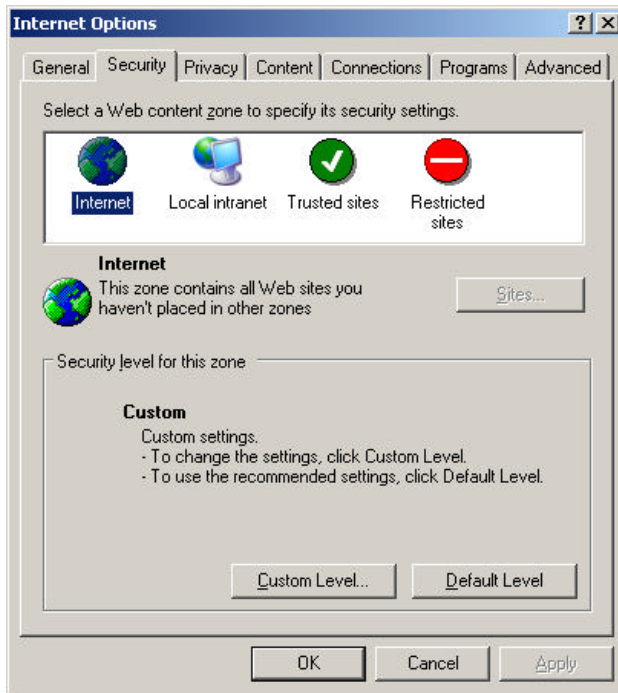
Open an Internet Explorer window and navigate to <http://www.pcusa.org/ga217/>.

Click on the Login to Les button.

After Les loads, select the Tools menu and slide down to Internet Options:



In the Internet Options control window, select the Security tab and click the green circle labeled Trusted Sites:



In the Trusted Sites control, ensure that there is NOT a check in the box labeled Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone.

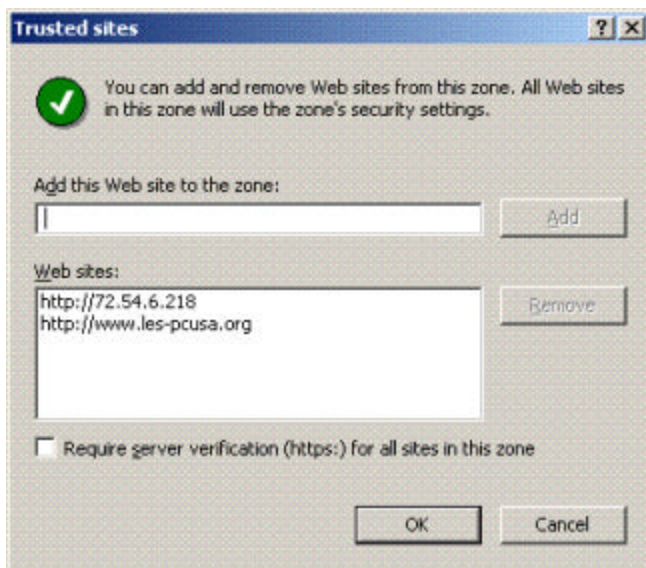
Then type this URL into the line labeled Add this web site to the zone:

<http://72.54.6.218> and click Add

Then do the same with this URL:

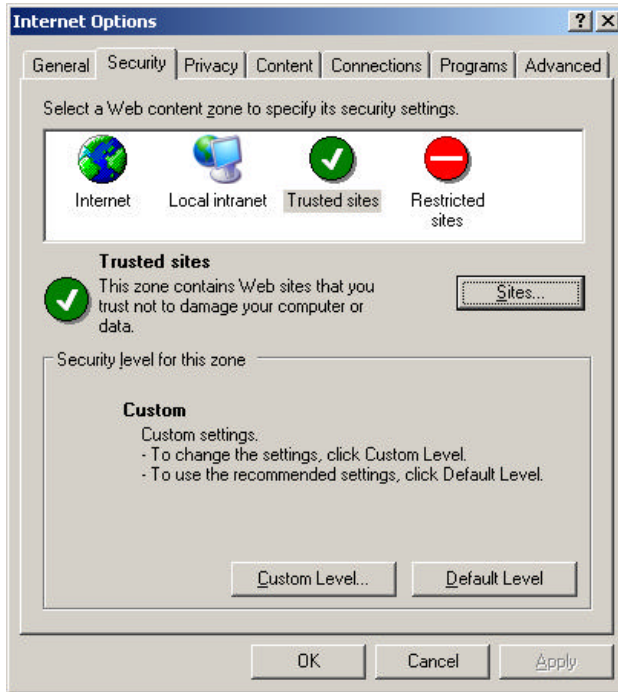
<http://www.les-pcusa.org> and click Add

After adding those two URLs, the window should look like this:

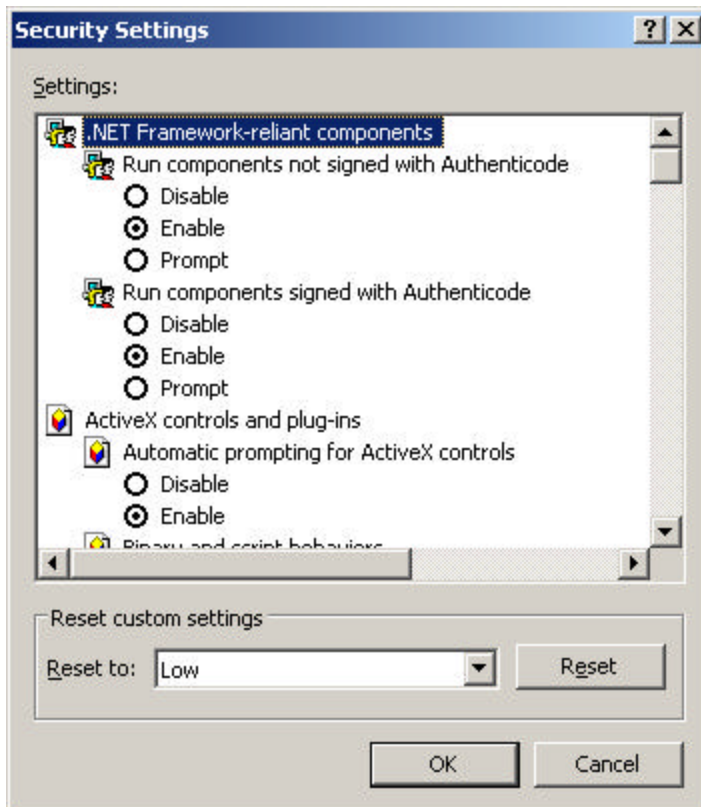


When it does, click OK.

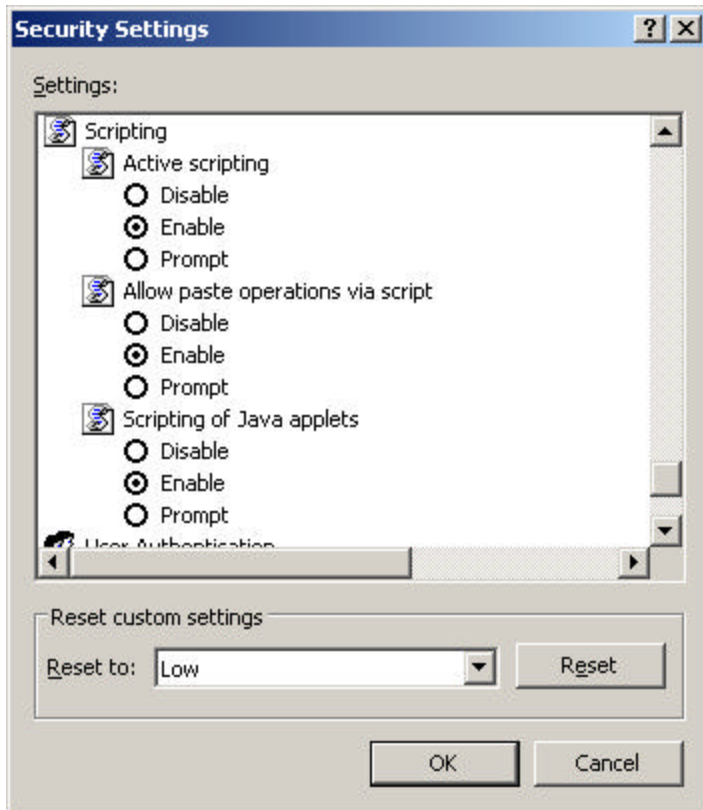
That will take you back to this screen:



Click Custom Level just above the OK button. That will take you to this screen:



Scroll down to Scripting and ensure that Enable is selected in Active Scripting, Allow Paste Operations Via Script and Scripting of Java Applets:



Click OK in this window and in any resulting dialog box.

Then click OK to save and exit the Internet Option control.

Close all Internet Explorer windows and open a new one.
